CULTIVAR NAME _____ 'Canyon Gray'

COMMON NAME _____ Canyon Gray Sagebrush

FAMILY NAME _____ Asteraceae

ORIGIN _____ This prostrate form of *A. californica* was found growing in a wind-swept area on San Miguel Island by Ralph Philbrick, former director of Santa Barbara Botanic Garden.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION _____ Dense semi-evergreen shrub, spreading to 10 ft or more, yet remaining about 2 ft tall. Leaves are deeply lobed and highly aromatic when crushed. Flowers are fairly inconspicuous.

WATER REQUIREMENTS _____ Tolerates drought conditions in southern California, but also accepts moderate summer water.

SOIL REQUIREMENTS _____ Wide soil tolerance.

EXPOSURE REQUIREMENTS _____ Full sun in coastal areas.

PESTS AND DISEASES _____ No known pests or diseases.

HARDINESS _____ Zones 7-9, 14-24.

LANDSCAPE VALUE _____ 'Canyon Gray' is a large-scale groundcover. Its fine-textured, silver-gray foliage is especially beautiful in rock gardens or covering hill-sides.

PROPAGATION _____ Easily grown from cuttings.

SALES POTENTIAL _____ For those seeking an easy-care, water-thrifty, fine-textured groundcover, 'Canyon Gray' offers all this and aromatic foliage too.
